

Resurrection Rolls - Snack (To be used in Session 7)

6e

Ingredients

- can refrigerated crescent dough
- sugar
- cinnamon
- butter
- large marshmallows

Directions

- Preheat oven to 375°F. Roll out dough while the oven is heating.
- Spray a cookie sheet with cooking spray or line with parchment paper.
- Unroll crescent dough and separate each triangle. This is like the cloth they wrapped Jesus in.
- In one child or big marshmallow in melted butter. Roll in cinnamon and sugar mixture. The marshmallow represents Jesus. The butter, cinnamon, and sugar are like the oil and spices used to prepare a body for burial.
- Place marshmallow in the top of the crescent roll and roll into a crescent roll shape, then secure the rolls by tucking them under and pinching them closed. This is symbolic of how they wrapped Jesus' body when they put him in the tomb.
- Place on prepared cookie sheet.
- Bake in preheated oven for 8-10 minutes or until golden brown on the outside. The oven is like the tomb. Read John 20:1-9 while the rolls are baking.
- Open the tucks (the seal) and remove the rolls. Cool. If the marshmallows have seeped out, remove the rolls.
- Let cool for a few minutes and then let the children pick a roll to open up. What happened to the marshmallow? The marshmallow has disappeared, just like Jesus did when he was resurrected!
- Enjoy!
